# CAEN-OUISTREHAM



Organised as a series of terminals along a 15 km long canal between Caen and the sea, the port of Caen-Ouistreham is virtually adjacent to the regional capital. It benefits from being close to Paris and the first ferry link on the west of the straight. It offers renovated, modular buildings dedicated to the marine sector and is close to a unique business incubator specialising in services for pleasure boats. Its wet docks and the canal offer a perfect setting for boat trials.

#### Nouveau Bassin dock area

- 3 ha fenced-off port yards

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#### **CAEN TECHMER**

Companies in the Caen-area marine sector decided to join forces and set up Caen TechMer, thereby forming the largest grouping of maritime professionals in the capital Normandy.

# **CHERBOURG**



Situated in the centre of the English Channel, with 24-hour port access, Cherbourg is protected by one of the largest artificial harbours in the world, covering 15 km² and practicable 365 days a year - ideal for boat trials. As Normandy's largest ship and boat building site, the port boasts top-tier infrastructures and facilities which are invaluable to the business development of the different ship and boatyards.

With 4 ferry routes to England and Ireland, the port is particularly well connected to the British Isles.

4,000 m<sup>2</sup> of buildings and 3 ha of modular building plots are available for rental 500 m from the vessel lifting equipment, to allow boat builders and repairers to set up business at the port.

# **DIEPPE**



The port in a city, the city in a port. Dieppe couldn't be more closely bound to the sea and its port, a place that has produced innumerable privateers, explorers and shipowners. The city has therefore forged a culture of rising to challenges and of innovation, which has seen it develop a certain specialist know-how in the construction and repair of fishing vessels. Situated in the middle of the Paris-London axis, accessible by ferry from Newhaven in 4 hours, the port has, in parallel, developed their infrastructures and facilities over the years to sustain a thriving fishing port: fish landing and auction, boat building and repair, and so on.
